TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Participation at the Australian Riichi Mahjong Open 2025 ("The Event") requires the participant to accept all terms and conditions as stated in this document.
2. The participant agrees to indemnify the Australian Riichi Mahjong Association and the organisers of The Event ("Event Organisers") against all claims resulting from damage, death or injury suffered in connection with The Event.
3. The participant acknowledges that they may be excluded from The Event, and/or any future events held by the Event Organisers, if:
 - a) They perform any actions which are deemed by the Event Organisers to be contrary to the World Riichi Championship Standards of Conduct, which can be found at:

 - b) They perform any actions, including (but not limited to) cheating or collusion, which are deemed by the Event Organisers to affect the competitive integrity of The Event.
 - c) They perform any actions which are deemed by the Event Organisers to be unsafe or otherwise harmful to the physical or mental wellbeing of staff or other participants.
4. The participant agrees:
 - a) With the refund policy for tickets to The Event as stated on the Meetup registration website.
 - b) That they are entitled to a refund of their entry fee only if they refund their ticket through the Meetup website 30 days prior to The Event.
 - c) That they are not entitled to a refund due to reasons including, but not limited to:
 - i. Failure to attend The Event.
 - ii. Exclusion from The Event due to any reasons stated in Clause 3.
5. The participant agrees that their personal information collected as part of The Event registration may be used:
 - a) To contact the participant regarding The Event.

6. The participant agrees to give the Event Organisers and the WRC Committee the irrevocable right to record their image, voice, biographical information, or other information about them on photographs / images / audio recordings / video recordings and other materials at The Event. The recorded materials may be used for the purposes of advertising, media publicity, publication, or general display in relation to The Event, the World Riichi Championship, or Australian Riichi Mahjong Association activities.
7. The Event Organisers reserve all rights in relation to The Event, including but not limited to the making of changes, revisions, or amendments, or the addition or removal of sections of the terms and conditions in this document, without prior notification to the participant.
